

Introduction (effective January 20, 2021)

ArvzApp Inc. (“ArvzApp” or the “Company”) is committed to protecting the privacy of individuals who visit the Company’s web site and individuals who use the Services as defined below (“Customers”). This Privacy Policy describes ArvzApp’s privacy practices in relation to the use of the Company’s web sites, mobile apps, and the related applications and services offered by ArvzApp (collectively, the “Services”).

Our principle guidelines are simple. We will be clear about the data we collect and why. We do not and will not sell your data to third parties. The prime purpose of collecting your data is to assist you in using our travel, deals, live cam, and entertainment gateways.

This Privacy Policy (the ‘Policy’) explains the personal information we collect from you, either directly or indirectly, and how we use it. As used in this Policy, “Personal Information” has the meaning provided in the EU General Data Protection Regulation of 2018 (the “GDPR”), and includes any information which, either alone or when combined with other information we hold, identifies an individual, such as name, mailing address, email address, IP address, and telephone number. For legal residents of California, who are covered by the California Consumer Privacy Act (“CCPA”), Personal Information includes any additional elements defined as such by the CCPA. Further, for legal residents of other states within the U.S. covered by other applicable laws, Personal Information includes any additional elements defined as such by such applicable laws. By contrast, “Anonymous Data” means any data that, alone or combined with other information available to us or a third party, does not permit identification of an individual. We collect both Personal Information and Anonymous Data as described below. It typically includes such information as your name, e-mail address, or mailing address. This Policy also covers the choices you can make about the data we collect, and how you can control these decisions. Please read this Policy carefully to understand how ArvzApp may collect, use, and share your personal information. The terms ‘we’, ‘us’, or ‘ArvzApp’ are each intended as reference to ArvzApp, Inc.

Changes

We will update this Policy when necessary to reflect legal changes, customer feedback, and changes in our Services. When we post changes to this Policy, we will revise the “effective” date at the top of the Policy and may describe the changes in a change history. If there are material changes to the Policy or in how ArvzApp will use your personal information, we may notify you either by prominently posting a notice of such changes before they take effect or by directly sending you a notification. We encourage you to periodically review this Policy to learn how ArvzApp is protecting your information. Your continued use of our Services following the posting and/or notification of changes constitutes your acknowledgement and/or acceptance of such changes.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION (EU AND CALIFORNIA USERS)

EU Users

Who We Are

For the purpose of the GDPR or other applicable legal framework, and depending on the specific Personal Information of interest, the data controller of your specific Personal Information of interest is either the Content Provider to whom you have made your data available, or ArvzApp. You may contact our data protection officer at info@arvzapp.com.

California Users

Sale of Personal Data

You may opt out of all sales of your Personal Information. We never exchange Personal Information for money or any other consideration (e.g., trade it for free services). However, the CCPA's definition of "sale" is very broad, and may include situations where, for example, browsing data is sent to a third party. We, along with millions of other sites, use these services. We limit the information sent to what is needed to properly fulfill our contractual obligations. The Types of Personal Information We Collect

Information you provide to us

We collect information from you directly that you voluntarily provide to us, such as your name and email address; for instance, when you want to update your profile or when you contact our Us for assistance.

Information we collect automatically

We automatically collect information about you, such as data about your use of Our services. We may, for example, collect information about the type of device you use to access our websites, the operating system and version, your IP address, your general geographic location as indicated by your IP address, your browser type, the webpages you view on our websites, and whether and how you interact with content available on our websites and apps.

Information obtained from other sources

We may receive information about you from other sources, including third parties, such as ArvzApp partners and partners with whom we offer co-branded services or engage in joint marketing activities. We may also receive information about you from ArvzApp partner websites, for instance, when you interact with us on those sites. We protect data obtained from

third parties according to the practices described in this Policy and we also apply any additional restrictions imposed by the source of data.

Information of children

ArvzApp does not target and is not intended to attract children under sixteen. Although visitors of all ages may navigate through our websites or use our app, we do not knowingly collect or request personal information from those under the age of sixteen without parental consent. If, following a notification by a parent or guardian or discovery by other means, a child under sixteen has improperly accessed or used our Services by using false information, we will delete the child's personal information from our records.

Customer Interactions with ArvzApp

To make the information in this Policy easy to understand, we have highlighted different occasions when ArvzApp could potentially collect personal information from customers. The customer interactions with ArvzApp are broken down into the following segments:

Learning about ArvzApp

As you gather more information about ArvzApp, you may virtually or physically visit or interact with a site that we own or operate. Examples include browsing our website, calling our representatives, or attending ArvzApp-sponsored events. To learn more about ArvzApp Services, you may voluntarily provide personal information, such as your name and email address during these interactions. We may also collect information about you online when you visit our websites.

We collect: name, email address, phone number, and IP address.

Why: We use this information to share news about events, and Services offered by ArvzApp. Additionally, the IP address helps us to understand geographic information about our websites' visitors better so that we can improve our websites for everyone, and for the providing of our Services which are user-location dependent. It is our legitimate interest to process your personal data for these purposes, and is also necessary for the performance of the agreement we have with you as our end user.

Updating your profile

When you update your profile, we allow you to enter or modify certain information. You may voluntarily provide personal information such as your first name, last name, and email.

We collect: first name, last name, email address, and image.

Why: We use this information to notify you of activities and events within Our Services depending on your notification preferences, identify your associated assets, such as videos, locations of interest, event credentials, identify you to other authorized Partners in Our system, properly display content in Our Services, and authenticate access to content based. Processing your personal data for these purposes is necessary for the performance of the agreement we have with you.

Submitting comments or reviews

The ArvzApp Service is a content distribution platform for the benefit and enjoyment of our users, and may allow for the submission of comments and reviews in certain cases.

We collect: Comments and reviews, including text-based and video-based.

Why: We use this information to facilitate transparency as to the quality of the content and the Partner and third-party services associated therewith. Processing your personal data for these purposes is necessary for the performance of the agreement we have with you.

Getting Help from ArvzApp

From time to time, you may decide to contact Us for assistance with the ArvzApp Services, such as if you are having issues with playback or interactions with our Partners. To be able to offer you the best service possible, we may collect certain data from you.

We collect: This may include contact information, such as your name, email address, phone number, and the content of your chats and other communications with ArvzApp.

Why: We collect this information to give you the best and most efficient customer support possible. For instance, for Customer inquiries and technical questions, we use contact information to respond to the Customer in their preferred channel (e.g., phone or email). Processing your personal data for this purpose is necessary for the performance of the agreement we have with you.

How We Use Personal Information

ArvzApp uses the data we collect to provide you with the Services we offer, which includes using data to improve your experiences. We also use the data to communicate with you, for example, informing you about, new Services available, security, and other types of updates.

ArvzApp uses the data for the following purposes:

Providing our Product Experience

We use data to provide, operate, support and improve the Services we offer to ensure our customers can find and access content as easily as possible. This processing is necessary for the performance of our agreement we have with you.

Customer Support

We use data to respond to customer inquiries, diagnose problems using the Services, address technical issues, and provide other customer care and support services. This processing is necessary for the performance of our agreement we have with you, as well as to serve our legitimate interest.

Service Improvement

We continually use data for research purposes and to develop and improve Our Services, including maintaining and improving the performance of Our Services, developing and adding new features or capabilities, such as using verification to improve security, and using usage data to determine what new features to prioritize. This processing is necessary to serve our legitimate interest.

Security, Safety and Dispute Resolution

We use data to protect the security and safety of Our Services and our customers, to detect and prevent fraud, to resolve disputes and enforce our agreements. This processing is necessary to serve our legitimate interest.

Business Operations

We use data to develop aggregate analysis and business intelligence that enable us to operate, protect, make informed decisions, and report on the performance of our business. This processing is necessary to serve our legitimate interest.

Communication, Marketing, and Advertising

We use the data we collect to deliver and personalize our communications with you. For example, we may contact you by email or other means of electronic communication to inform you about new ArvzApp Services, to update you on a support issue or to invite you to take part in a survey. This processing is necessary to serve our legitimate interest. We also use cookies and similar technologies to provide the most relevant ArvzApp advertising to you. For information about managing email subscriptions and promotional communications, please see below.

How We May Share Personal Information

ArvzApp does not and will not sell personal information about our users. We only disclose your data as described in this Policy. We may share information with the following types of third parties.

Compelled Disclosure

When legally required, strictly necessary for the performance of the services or to protect our rights, or the rights of our affiliates or users, we disclose your personal information to law enforcement authorities, investigative organizations, our affiliates or in legal proceedings.

Sale or Merger

We may share your personal information in the event of a merger, acquisition, or sale of all or a portion of our assets. We will also share information with that company, including at the negotiation stage.

The Legal Bases for Using Personal Information

There are different legal bases that we rely on to use your personal information, namely:

Performance of a contract

The use of your personal information may be necessary to perform the agreement you have with us. For example, to process your access saved live feeds, to search for available live feeds based on your current or intended location, to post comments or reviews, to help with technical issues, and to respond to your requests.

Legitimate interests

We may use your personal information for our legitimate interests. For example, we rely on our legitimate interest to analyze and improve ArvzApp Services, to send you notifications about ArvzApp Services, or to use your personal information for administrative, fraud detection or legal purposes.

Where we process your personal information based on our legitimate interest and no opt-out mechanism is available to you on our website, you may exercise your right to object by sending an email to info@arvzapp.com.

Security, Storage and Retention of Personal Information We Collect

Security

ArvzApp is committed to protecting the security of your personal information. However, while we take reasonable precautions to guard the personal information we collect, no security system is impenetrable.

We use a variety of appropriate technical and organizational measures and industry standards to protect your personal information and help prevent information about you from loss, theft, misuse and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration and destruction. For example, we store the personal data you provide on computer systems that have limited access and are in

controlled facilities. We ensure that our data center has adequate security measures. Additionally, your data is protected with encryption, such as Transport Layer Security (TLS), during transmission over the Internet. You can only access your information and our service through the use of an individual user login and password. To protect the confidentiality of your personal information, you must keep your password confidential and not disclose it to any other person. Please alert us immediately if you believe your password has been misused. Additionally, always log out and close your browser when you finish using the Services. Please note, we will never ask you to disclose your password.

Storage

Personal data collected by ArvzApp may be stored and processed in your region, in the United States (for instance in our data centers), or in any other country where ArvzApp is located or maintains facilities. ArvzApp has put in place adequate mechanisms to protect personal information when it is transferred internationally.

Retention

ArvzApp will retain your personal information for as long as we deem it necessary to enable you to use the website and ArvzApp Services, to provide services to you, to comply with applicable laws (including those regarding document retention), and resolve disputes with any parties and otherwise as necessary to allow us to conduct our business. All personal information we retain will be subject to this Policy and our internal retention guidelines. If you have a question about a specific retention period for certain types of personal information we process about you, please send an email to info@arvzapp.com.

Your Rights and Choices

Your Rights

We want you to be in control of how your personal information is used by us. Subject to local law, you can do this in the following ways:

- you can ask us for a copy of the personal information we hold about you;
- you can inform us of any changes to your personal information, or if you want us to correct any of the personal information we hold about you;
- in certain situations, you can ask us to erase, block or restrict the personal information we hold about you, or object to particular ways in which we are using your personal information; and
- in certain situations, you can also ask us to send the personal information you have given us to a third party.

Where we are using your personal information on the basis of your consent, you are entitled to withdraw that consent at any time. Moreover, where we process your personal information based on legitimate interest or the public interest, you have the right to object at any time to that use of your personal information.

We rely on you to ensure that your personal information is complete, accurate and current. Please inform us promptly of any changes to, or inaccuracies of, your personal information by contacting info@arvzapp.com.

We will respond to your request as soon as possible but certainly within 30 days.

We are committed to working with you to obtain a fair resolution of any complaint or concern you may have about our use of your personal information. If, however, you believe that we have not been able to assist with your complaint or concern, you may have the right to lodge a complaint with the data protection authority in your country (if one exists in your country) or supervisory authority.

Rights for EU and California Users Only

The GDPR and CCPA grant EU and California residents certain rights regarding their Personal Information, including the right to access and modify Personal Information held by providers (like us), and to have providers “forget” Personal Information that is no longer relevant. You may always contact us for assistance in exercising these rights. Please include information about which rights you are seeking to exercise if you contact us. We may need to verify your identity before fulfilling your request. It should not need to be said, but we will never provide worse services to, or in any way punish anyone who chooses to exercise these rights.

You have the following rights with respect to your Personal Information that we process. Except where indicated, these rights apply equally to EU and California users:

- **Withdraw Consent:** You may withdraw your consent to our processing of your Personal Information, in whole or in part (i.e., for marketing purposes). Certain Services may be ineffective upon opt out.
- **Access / Request Information:** You may access the Personal Information we hold about you at any time by contacting us directly.
- **Modification:** You may modify the Personal Information we hold about you at any time via by contacting us directly.
- **Erase and Forget.** In certain situations, for example when the Personal Information we hold about you is no longer relevant or accurate, you can request that we erase your Personal Information. If you delete your account, all Personal Information will be erased within thirty days of the date of deletion.
- **Portability:** you may request a copy of your Personal Information and may always move it to other entities as you desire.

- No Sale of Personal Data (California Users only): Go to the Do Not Sell My Personal Information page to stop all “sale” of your Personal Data.

ACCESS TO SPECIFIC INFORMATION AND DATA PORTABILITY RIGHTS

You have the right to request that ArvzApp disclose certain information to you about our collection and use of your personal information over the past 12 months. Once we receive and confirm your verifiable consumer request, we will disclose to you:

- The categories of personal information we collected about you.
- The categories of sources for the personal information we collected about you.
- Our business or commercial purpose for collecting or selling that personal information.
- The categories of third parties with whom we share that personal information.
- The specific pieces of personal information we collected about you (also called a data portability request).
- If we sold or disclosed your personal information for a business purpose, two separate lists disclosing:
 - sales, identifying the personal information categories that each category of recipient purchased; and
 - disclosures for a business purpose, identifying the personal information categories that each category of recipient obtained.

DELETION REQUEST RIGHTS

You have the right to request that ArvzApp delete any of your personal information that we collected from you and retained, subject to certain exceptions. Once we receive and confirm your verifiable consumer request (see Exercising Access, Data Portability, and Deletion Rights), we will delete (and direct our service providers to delete) your personal information from our records, unless an exception applies.

We may deny your deletion request if retaining the information is necessary for us or our Partners or third-party service provider(s) to:

- Complete the transaction for which we collected the personal information, provide a good or service that you requested, take actions reasonably anticipated within the context of our ongoing business relationship with you, or otherwise perform our contract with you.
- Detect security incidents, protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity, or prosecute those responsible for such activities.
- Debug products to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality.
- Exercise free speech, ensure the right of another consumer to exercise their free speech rights, or exercise another right provided for by law.
- Comply with the California Electronic Communications Privacy Act (Cal. Penal Code § 1546 et. seq.).

- Engage in public or peer-reviewed scientific, historical, or statistical research in the public interest that adheres to all other applicable ethics and privacy laws, when the information's deletion may likely render impossible or seriously impair the research's achievement, if you previously provided informed consent.
- Enable solely internal uses that are reasonably aligned with consumer expectations based on your relationship with us.
- Comply with a legal obligation.
- Make other internal and lawful uses of that information that are compatible with the context in which you provided it.

EXERCISING ACCESS, DATA PORTABILITY, AND DELETION RIGHTS

To exercise the access, data portability, and deletion rights described above, please submit a verifiable consumer request to us by contacting us at:

Only you, or if a California resident, a person registered with the California Secretary of State that you authorize to act on your behalf, may make a verifiable consumer request related to your personal information. You may also make a verifiable consumer request on behalf of your minor child.

You may only make a verifiable consumer request for access or data portability twice within a 12-month period. The verifiable consumer request must:

- Provide sufficient information that allows us to reasonably verify you are the person about whom we collected personal information or an authorized representative.
- Describe your request with sufficient detail that allows us to properly understand, evaluate, and respond to it.

We cannot respond to your request or provide you with personal information if we cannot verify your identity or authority to make the request and confirm the personal information relates to you.

Making a verifiable consumer request does not require you to create an account with us. We will only use personal information provided in a verifiable consumer request to verify the requestor's identity or authority to make the request.

RESPONSE TIMING AND FORMAT

We endeavor to respond to a verifiable consumer request within forty-five (45) days of its receipt. If we require more time (up to 90 days), we will inform you of the reason and extension period in writing.

If you have an account with us, we will deliver our written response to that account. If you do not have an account with us, we will deliver our written response by mail or electronically, at your option.

Any disclosures we provide will only cover the 12-month period preceding the verifiable consumer request's receipt. The response we provide will also explain the reasons we cannot comply with a request, if applicable. For data portability requests, we will select a format to provide your personal information that is readily useable and should allow you to transmit the information from one entity to another entity without hindrance.

We do not charge a fee to process or respond to your verifiable consumer request unless it is excessive, repetitive, or manifestly unfounded. If we determine that the request warrants a fee, we will tell you why we made that decision and provide you with a cost estimate before completing your request.

PERSONAL INFORMATION SALES OPT-OUT AND OPT-IN RIGHTS

If you are 16 years of age or older, you have the right to direct us to not sell your personal information at any time (the "right to opt-out"). We do not sell the personal information of consumers we actually know are less than 16 years of age, unless we receive affirmative authorization (the "right to opt-in") from either the consumer who is between 13 and 16 years of age, or the parent or guardian of a consumer who is between 13 and 16 years of age. Consumers who opt-in to personal information sales may opt-out of future sales at any time.

If you wish to exercise any of these rights, please contact us at info@arvzapp.com, or write us at the address below. In your request, please make clear: (i) what Personal Information is concerned; and (ii) which of the above rights you would like to enforce. For your protection, we may only fulfil requests with respect to the Personal Information associated with the email address you send your request from, and we will need to verify your identity before doing so (which is typically done by having you make the request from within the Services). We will comply with your request promptly, but in any event within thirty (30) days of your request (forty-five (45) days for requests under the CCPA). We may need to retain certain information for recordkeeping purposes or to complete transactions that you began prior to requesting such change or deletion.

We will not discriminate against you for exercising any of your CCPA rights. Unless permitted by the CCPA, we will not:

- Deny you goods or services.
- Charge you different prices or rates for goods or services, including through granting discounts or other benefits, or imposing penalties.
- Provide you a different level or quality of goods or services.
- Suggest that you may receive a different price or rate for goods or services or a different level or quality of goods or services.

However, we may offer you certain financial incentives permitted by the CCPA that can result in different prices, rates, or quality levels. Any CCPA-permitted financial incentive we offer will reasonably relate to your personal information's value and contain written terms that describe the program's material aspects. Participation in a financial incentive program requires your prior opt-in consent, which you may revoke at any time.

OTHER CALIFORNIA PRIVACY RIGHTS

California's "Shine the Light" law (Civil Code Section § 1798.83) permits users of our Site that are California residents to request certain information regarding our disclosure of personal information to third parties for their direct marketing purposes. Service data submissions

Your Communication, Marketing and Advertising Preferences

You can opt out of receiving direct marketing communications from ArvzApp by following the instructions included in every email sent to you via the "Unsubscribe" link. We respect your choice, and we will stop sending you promotional emails once you unsubscribe.

Please note we will continue to communicate with you regarding changes to terms and conditions, policy updates, ArvzApp Service updates, routine customer service messages such as information about service interruptions, data breaches, or other significant information about your use of the Services.

Our Use of Cookies and Other Similar Technologies

We use cookies and similar technologies to help us personalize our websites for you, remember your preferences, understand how users are using our websites or app, and help customize our marketing offerings.

Cookies

A 'cookie' is a small data file containing a string of characters that is sent to your computer when you visit a website. When you visit the website again, the cookie allows that site to recognize your browser. The length of time a cookie will stay on your computer or mobile device depends on whether it is a "persistent" or "session" cookie. ArvzApp uses both types of cookies. Session cookies will only stay on your device until you stop browsing. Persistent cookies stay on your computer or mobile device until they expire or are deleted. We use the following types of cookies on our website.

- Strictly necessary cookies. These cookies are essential for you to browse our website and use its features. Without these cookies, services like shopping baskets cannot be provided.
- Performance cookies. These cookies collect information about how you use our websites. This data may be used to help optimize our website and make it easier for you to navigate.
- Functional cookies. These cookies allow our websites to remember choices you make and personalize your experience. We may store your geographic location in a cookie, for instance, to ensure that we show you the websites relevant to your area.
- Third Party cookies. Third-party cookies are those placed by websites and/or parties other than ArvzApp. These cookies may be used on our websites to improve our products or services or to help us provide more relevant advertising. These cookies are subject to the respective privacy policies for these external services.
- Analytics cookies. We use analytics cookies, like those offered by Google Analytics, to help us understand things like how long a visitor stays on our websites, what pages they find most useful and how they arrived at arvazapp.com. How to control cookie settings

Most web browsers allow you to control cookies through their settings preferences. However if you limit the ability of websites to set cookies, you may impact your overall user experience. Some browsers offer a "Do Not Track" ("DNT") signal whereby you may indicate your preference regarding tracking and cross-site tracking. Although we do not currently employ technology that recognizes DNT signals, we will only process your personal data in accordance with this Privacy Policy. Advertising and Modern Marketing Tools

ArvzApp may work with third-party advertisers that use cookies and similar technologies to provide more relevant advertising about ArvzApp products and services on our websites and across the internet. To provide this ‘interest-based advertising’, the parties combine non-personal data about your online activities acquired over time, which help cater advertising that we deliver to you. Examples of this may include a ArvzApp advertisement on a Facebook page, or a Google-owned page such as a search results page or YouTube, or on a site within Google’s advertising network. We do not share your personal information as part of this process. Where necessary we obtain your consent to this process. The following are basic questions you may have about our Policy. We encourage you to read the detailed statement above for additional details.

Why is ArvzApp updating its Privacy Policy?

We now meet the high standard required by the European Union’s General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and have updated our Privacy Policy to reflect that. As the Court of Justice of the European Union (“CJEU”) has ruled that international data flows under the European Union’s comprehensive data protection regime, the GDPR, can continue to be based on EU Standard Contractual Clauses, while the EU–U.S. Privacy Shield has been declared invalid, references suggesting reliance on the EU–U.S. Privacy Shield have been removed.

What is the GDPR?

The GDPR is a regulation intended to strengthen and unify data protection for everyone within the European Union (EU). And because we believe that all our customers can benefit from its mandates, we’re implementing it globally. The GDPR requires greater openness and transparency from companies on how they collect, store and use personal data, while also imposing tighter limits on the use of personal data. What is the CCPA?

The CCPA was created to protect the privacy and data of consumers. The CCPA initiative states that the act is intended to “give Californians the ‘who, what, where, and when’ of how businesses handle consumers’ personal information.” The act requires businesses tell consumers what data its collecting and gives consumers the right to say no to the sale of their personal information.

How often do you anticipate updating your Privacy Policy?

We will update our Policy as necessary to ensure that our policies are in line with international regulations, our product and business practices.

What information does ArvzApp collect about me?

ArvzApp collects your first name, last name, street address, city, state, postal code, country, phone number, email address, image, comments, reviews and the content of your chats and other communications with Us.

Why does ArvzApp need my information?

ArvzApp uses the data we collect to provide you the best experience within the Services we offer, which includes using data to improve your experiences. We also use the data to communicate with you, for example, informing you about your content subscriptions, new services available, security, and other types of updates.

How is my information used?
